The department of Women's and Gender Studies at the University of Missouri seeks applications for a two-year post-doctoral position in Transgender Studies or Queer Studies beginning in August of 2022. The specific area of specialization within transgender or queer studies is open, but we are particularly interested in the following subfields, transnational/global capitalisms (or feminisms), rurality, environmental justice, science and technology, critical legal studies, comparative racialization, or indigenous studies.

An earned doctoral degree in Women's, Gender, Sexuality Studies, or other related field is required prior to employment. The successful candidate is expected to teach two classes a semester, including introductory courses in Transgender studies and WGST, as well as developing new courses in their area of specialization. The successful candidate will also be expected to pursue an active research agenda.

The department of WGST is committed to providing strong mentorship for the successful candidate, including grant writing, professional development, and a writing group.

The University of Missouri (MU or Mizzou), located in Columbia, has an enrollment of more than 30,000 students and is Missouri's largest public research university.
